Peppermint Brittle

Ingredients- 2 pounds White Chocolate & 30 small peppermint candy canes



1. Line a large jellyroll pan with heavy-duty foil.
2. Place white chocolate in a microwave-safe bowl. Heat in microwave on medium setting for 5 to 6 minutes. Stir occasionally, until chocolate is melted and smooth.
3. Place candy canes in a plastic bag, or between two pieces of waxed paper. Using a mallet or rolling pin, break the candy canes into chunks.
4. Stir peppermint into melted white chocolate. Spread evenly in pan, and chill until set, about 1 hour. Break into pieces by slamming pan on counter.

Work on upgrade projects has progressed well this fall. The Tennis and Basketball courts have new fencing enclosing them. The Lodge had new insulated windows installed throughout and will be receiving a new heating and air-conditioning system. Paving projects have been completed, including a new road from Site 10 to Site 69 and a new parking area for our after hours check-in office by the entrance. Site upgrades continue with 50 amp metered pedestals being installed in several area's of the park.
